It is open to all Grade 12 students in all LDCSB secondary schools who are going on to post-secondary education. With determination and support from Elisabeth's family, friends, and the community her legacy will live on through the Elisabeth Steel Reurink Scholarship Fund. The name of the scholarship will be: *The Elisabeth Charlene Steel Reurink Children of the Light Memorial Award Scholarship*. The vision for the scholarship fund is to provide a tribute to Elisabeth who was an exceptional young person, to inspire excellence in other graduating high school students, and to provide a living legacy from the students of Elisabeth's graduating class to future students.

This award, in the amount of \$1000 will be given annually and will be presented to a deserving student for the first time this year on Wednesday June 10, 2009 at the Monsignor Feeney Foundation awards ceremony by the Steel Reurink family and the scholarship organizing committee – which is made up of Elisabeth's friends and classmates.
